

Five tattoos only clue, police yet to identify body found last year

NEARLY EIGHT months ago, the Juhu police recovered the body of a man in a semi-decomposed state near Irla nullah. Over a hundred people have been interrogated since, and all CCTV cameras installed near the spot have been scanned carefully, but the deceased — suspected to be in his early 30s — remains unidentified.

The only clue the police have are five tattoos on his body, including two names tattooed on his chest and one on his forearm.

The body was found near Irla nullah on December 31, 2017. Seven hours after the body was recovered, the Juhu police registered a case of murder and destruction of evidence with post-mortem reports from Cooper Hospital revealing that the man had died of a head injury.

The Juhu police formed four teams, each headed by a police sub-inspector, to investigate the case. The Crime Branch started a parallel probe in the case. "To begin with, we scrutinised the CCTV footage from around Irla. As we couldn't find anything, we started concentrating on the five tattoos on the man's body," said an officer.

The tattoos include a heart-shaped one on his forearm with the word 'Avatar'. The words 'Pravin' and 'Parveen' were tattooed on his chest, said police. The police found a steel pendant attached to a black thread on his body. A steel bracelet on his right wrist and a black string around his right ankle were also found, said investigators.

"From the look of the deceased and the bracelet, it appears that the man is a Punjabi. We approached several gurdwaras in the city to get clues on his identity. We circulated pictures of the deceased and the tattoos to gurdwaras in Punjab, Haryana, Delhi and Rajasthan," said an officer.

The investigator tried to trawl through social media profiles by the name of Avatar, Pravin and

KOPER KHAIRANE 2 major organisers won't celebrate Dahi Handi

Navi Mumbai: Two major Dahi Handi organisers at Koper Khairane in Navi Mumbai have decided not to celebrate the festival on September 3 in wake of the recent agitation by the Maratha community demanding quota in education and jobs. Koper Khairane had witnessed violent protests by the community.

The decision was announced in a social coordination meeting — attended by all stakeholders — held by the Navi Mumbai police on Monday. "We have been organising 'Samanway' meetings to address the complaints of all residents. On Monday, among other things, Dahi Handi was also discussed," said a police officer.

NCP legislator Narendra Patil, who also attended the meeting, said: "Vaibhav Naik of Kalash Udyan and Ashish Achare of the Teen Taaki ground, both from Koper Khairane, declared that they will not celebrate Dahi Handi."

"The area had seen a lot of violence between two communities during the Maratha agitation. We are working on trust-building exercises in the area... So, we felicitated the two organisers for the decision," said a police officer. ENS

One held for pushing woman off train

A 24-YEAR-OLD man was arrested on Monday for allegedly pushing a 58-year-old woman out of a train while trying to snatch her bag five days ago.

The woman, Pratibha Tripathi, had sustained injuries on her head and a fracture in her hand.

On August 22, Tripathi, who was headed to her sister's residence in Bengaluru, had boarded a train from platform 17 at CST.

As she called up her sister to inform that she had boarded the train, a man started pulling her bag and they entered into a scuffle. Eventually, the man pushed her and Tripathi fell out of the train, injuring her head and hand.

She then approached the CST GRP, where a case of robbery and attempt to murder was registered against an unidentified person.

Property tax records of civic body hacked

THE MIRA-BHAYANDER Municipal Corporation has lodged a complaint with the police last week, alleging that unidentified individuals have hacked into its property tax records and tampered with dues paid by 67 residents.

While the corporation filed a complaint with the Bhayander police station on August 23, the alleged tampering of the records

had come to its notice in June 2016. Police said that the complainant, an assistant commissioner with the corporation, has alleged that unidentified individuals had logged into her official email account on her office computer using her login ID and password, the police said.

The complaint has stated that in June 2016, the corporation had received an email from the income tax office regarding discrepancies in property tax records of several residents. An internal

investigation into the discrepancies revealed that the official's computer had been illegally accessed and that amounts paid in taxes by 67 individuals had been changed in its property tax database. In all, the unauthorised use of the computer revealed a discrepancy of Rs 10.28 lakh in property tax in financial year 2015-16.

"Unknown individuals have been booked on the charge of forgery under the IPC and the Information Technology Act," said Atul Kulkarni, Deputy Superintendent of Police.

TISS: PROFESSOR RAJNI KOTHARI LECTURE Students should be nonconformist and courageous: Nandita

IN THE run-up to the release of her film Manto, actor and acclaimed filmmaker Nandita Das exhorted students at the Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) on Monday to develop 'Mantoiyyat' in themselves, a free spiritedness, fearlessness and the ability to speak bluntly.

Students in contemporary India should be nonconformist and courageous, she said. Speaking at the Professor Rajni Kothari Lecture series at the School of Development Studies in TISS on the topic 'Experiencing Manto', Das said her film on Sadat Hassan Manto would be the most powerful interpretation of this spirit of the celebrated Indian-born writer who migrated to Lahore.

The film releases on September 21. Das said the idea behind her film is to "celebrate people like

Manto who have existed in all eras and who were misunderstood during their times."

"As a nation, we self-censor ourselves constantly. But Manto spoke his mind and he was even tried for obscenity six times. He argued his own cases. If I had to make a film with the same top without Manto, it would have seemed didactic. Some would say it is agenda driven, especially in times when the lines between news and views are blurred, when any commentary is going to polarise, so I took refuge behind Manto," she added.

Manto's words remain relevant even today, said Das. "Manto was born a Muslim but he went beyond religion and identity. He talked of humanity. He would say 'don't say ek lakh Hindu mare, yah ek lakh Muslim mare, yeh kaho ek lakh insaan mare'."

Danish Husain, who plays Manto's friend in the movie, said Manto's stories are stunning, living with readers for years.

Parveen. "We even contacted them and asked whether any relative was missing," said an investigator.

In January, the police received an information that a tattoo-maker from Surat had been reported missing.

"A team was instantly dispatched to Surat and after inquiring with the tattoo-maker's parents, we got his phone number and located him in Surat itself. We brought him in for inquiries and were satisfied that he was not involved. He was let off," said an investigator.

The police scanned the records of missing persons in Mumbai, Navi Mumbai, Thane, Delhi, Punjab and Haryana. The investigators approached security agencies and state transport associations to see if any of their personnel was reported missing. However, no major lead has emerged.

"We contacted the truck owners' association and asked them to circulate the photograph on WhatsApp groups where other transport owners and truck drivers are members. We also checked rented apartments in Juhu to ascertain if any person there has gone missing," said an officer.

Nearly eight months have passed, but investigators are yet to identify the man.

29-year-old man stabbed to death

Thane: A 29-year-old man was stabbed to death allegedly by three men after they had an argument on Sunday. Ulhasnagar police said the accused have been identified as Sunil Prajapati, Nitin Chaudhary and Ravi Jaiswar.

"The deceased, identified as Chandrakant More, worked as a salesman. He was out with his friends when an argument broke out between two groups. After some time, More and his friends walked away," said a police officer.

But the three accused followed More and his friends and attacked More with knives and rods, the police said. "More was stabbed multiple times and succumbed to the injuries before he could be taken to a hospital," the officer said.

"We have lodged a case of murder and provocation by insult against the three accused who are all residents of Ulhasnagar. They were taken in custody on Monday morning. We are investigating further to find out what led to the violence," a senior officer said.
